

## Minor in Sociology

A minor in sociology will prepare students to develop a framework for analyzing social relations from everyday life interactions to large-scale structural transformations. All sociology courses incorporate a theoretical, methodological, and practical component, helping students to learn to think critically about the social world from the local to the global. Students who minor in sociology are better prepared to seek careers in the 21<sup>st</sup> century economy including the non-profit sector, governmental agencies, business, and social services.

The Sociology minor requires 15 credit hours in sociology with 9 required hours at the 3000/4000 level.
