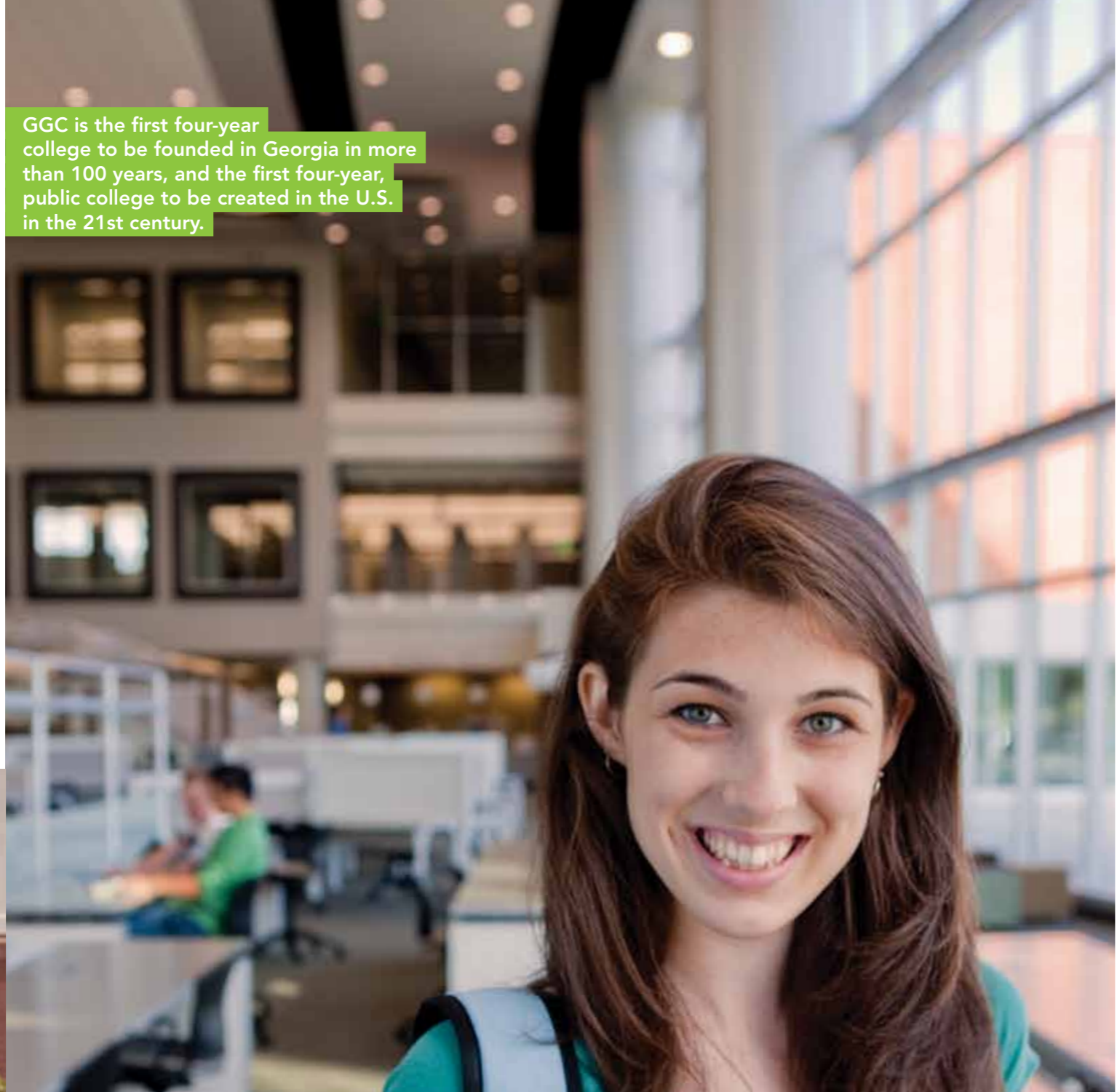

A Glimpse of GGC

History
GGC opened its doors in 2006 as the first four-year college to be founded in Georgia in more than 100 years, and the first four-year, public college to be created in the U.S. in the 21st century.

Campus
Located just 30 miles northeast of Atlanta in Lawrenceville, GGC spans more than 200 wooded acres. It offers easy access to Atlanta, Lake Lanier and Athens. Students live in modern, suite-style residence halls (flat screens come standard!), and the campus has everything a student needs including a fitness center and a new, state-of-the-art Library and Learning Center. The new Student Center includes a full-service Barnes & Noble bookstore.

Students
More than 5,000 students representing a diverse array of cultures and countries call themselves Grizzlies, and the numbers are climbing. The student body is 52 percent female and 48 percent male. Thirty-seven percent work at least 21 hours per week, thanks to our flexible classes.

Faculty
Nearly all of the full-time faculty hold PhDs or other terminal degrees. GGC is not a research institution, so they come here because they love to teach, advise, mentor and inspire. Since GGC ranks among the top 10 percent of colleges nationwide for student engagement and support, we'd like to keep it that way.

Technology
Every classroom is equipped with "smart" technology – which is partly how we got our nickname: The Campus of Tomorrow. From an entirely wireless campus to built-in recorders in every classroom, innovative teaching (and learning) is at the core of a GGC education.

Affordability
Tuition is only \$107 per credit, and full tuition is capped at \$1,600 per semester. In addition to the HOPE Scholarship, students can qualify for federal financial aid, including the Pell Grant and the Stafford Loan, among others. GGC's Office of Financial Aid will be glad to help you find funding. The way we see it, cost should never be a factor in getting a great education.
