

## Dedicated Guard Scholarship (DG)

The DG scholarship **can** be used with the HOPE and other scholarships. It **cannot** be used with chapters 1606 and 1607 of the GI Bill. The DG **cannot** be converted to a regular ROTC scholarship.

**Duration of scholarship:** This scholarship may be received for a maximum of three (3) years and a minimum of (one) 1 year.

**Restrictions:** Student must be enrolled (or plan to enroll) in the National Guard SMP program and attend training for one weekend a month and two weeks a year (usually over the summer).

**Commitment:** Recipients must commit to serve in the National Guard for eight (8) years (one weekend a month / two weeks a year).

**GPA:** Recipients must have and maintain a 2.5 college GPA

**Deployability:** Recipients will not be deployed during college; after graduation, they are deployable.

**Money:** Recipients are eligible for **either** full tuition and fees **or** room and board (up to \$10,000 if they live on campus and up to \$7,800 if they live off campus).

**Books:** \$1,200/year (\$600/semester)

### Stipend:

- \$300 per month for freshmen
- \$350 per month for sophomores
- \$450 per month for juniors
- \$500 per month for seniors

**Drill Pay:** Recipients will be paid at an E-5 rate for drill and Annual Training (\$247 per weekend)
