***Students are *strongly advised* to check with the program they plan to apply to for specific prerequisites; courses not offered at GGC can be taken elsewhere by transient student applications.**

Entrance exam requirements:

1. Take the Graduate Record Exam with the Analytical Writing portion.
2. Tests must be taken in time for the official results to be received (not postmarked) by the College by September 15th of the year you apply.

What factors are considered in the admission process for vet school students?

1. You must achieve one or both of the following: a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater and/or a combined score of 1,200 or greater on the verbal and quantitative portions of the GRE exam.
2. GRE Entrance exam scores
3. Evaluations from people who can evaluate your background fairly and judge your potential for entering the veterinary profession.
4. At least one evaluation form should be completed by a veterinarian you have been employed by or for whom you have done volunteer work.
5. A minimum of **250 veterinary experience hours** is required for all applicants.
