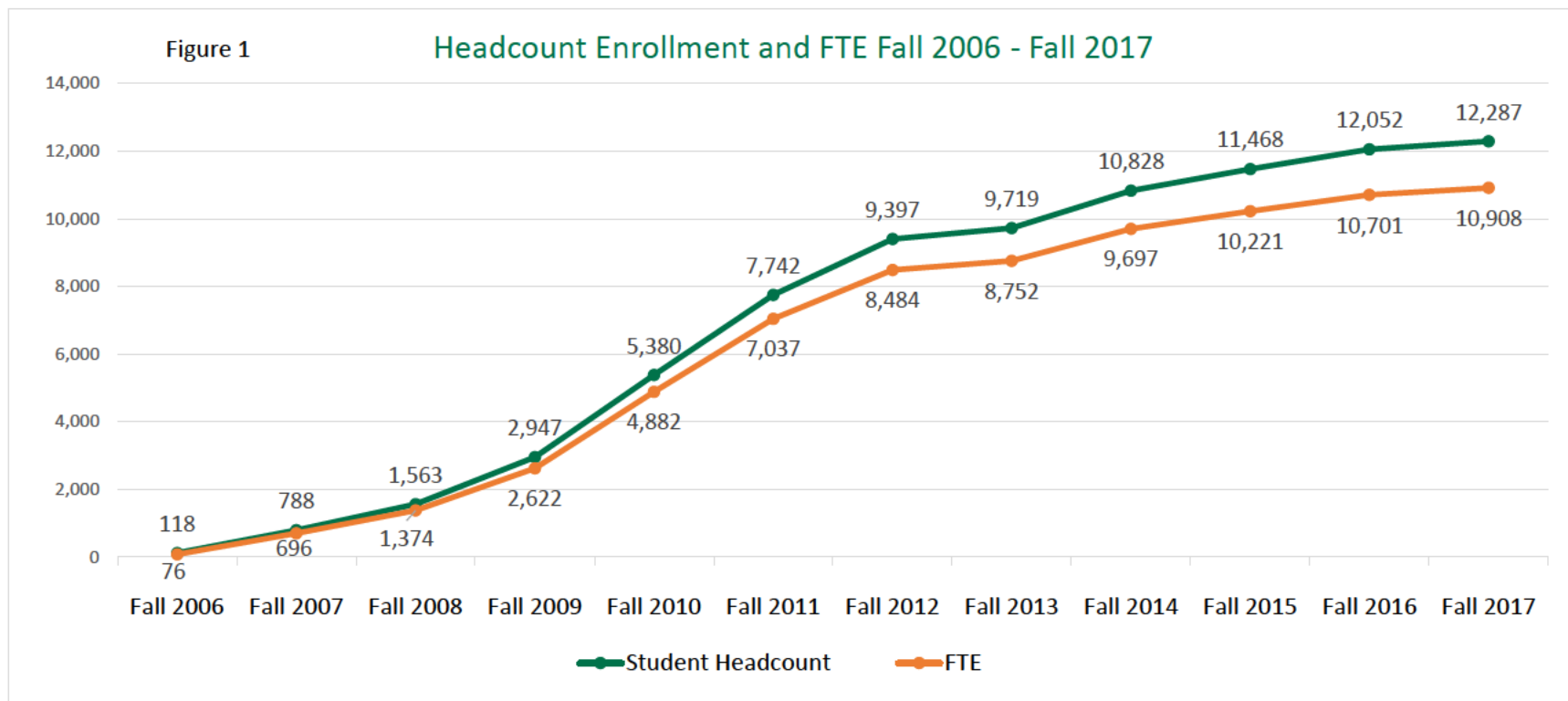

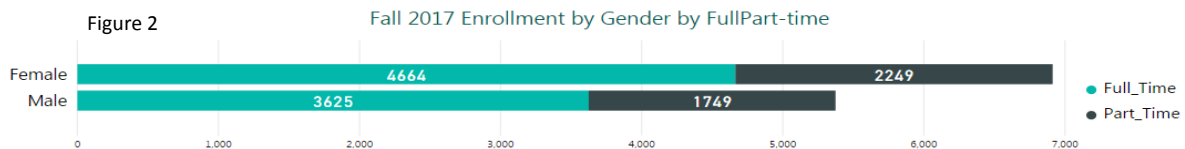

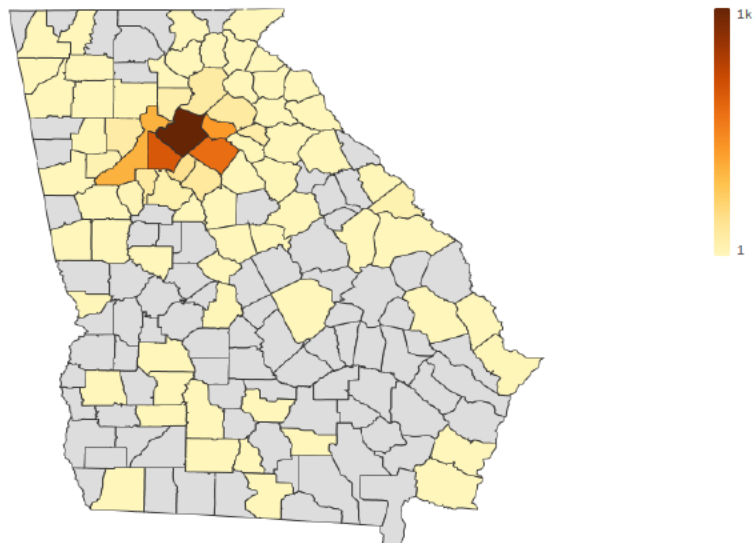

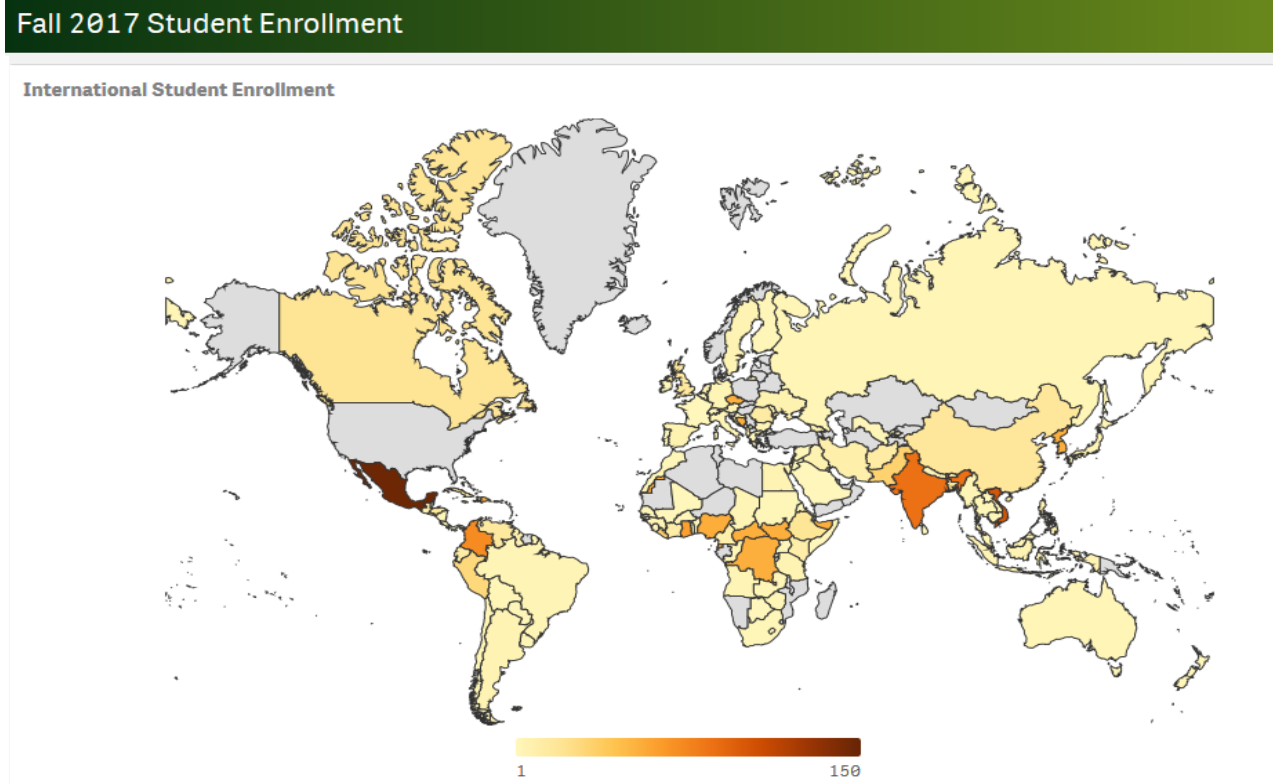

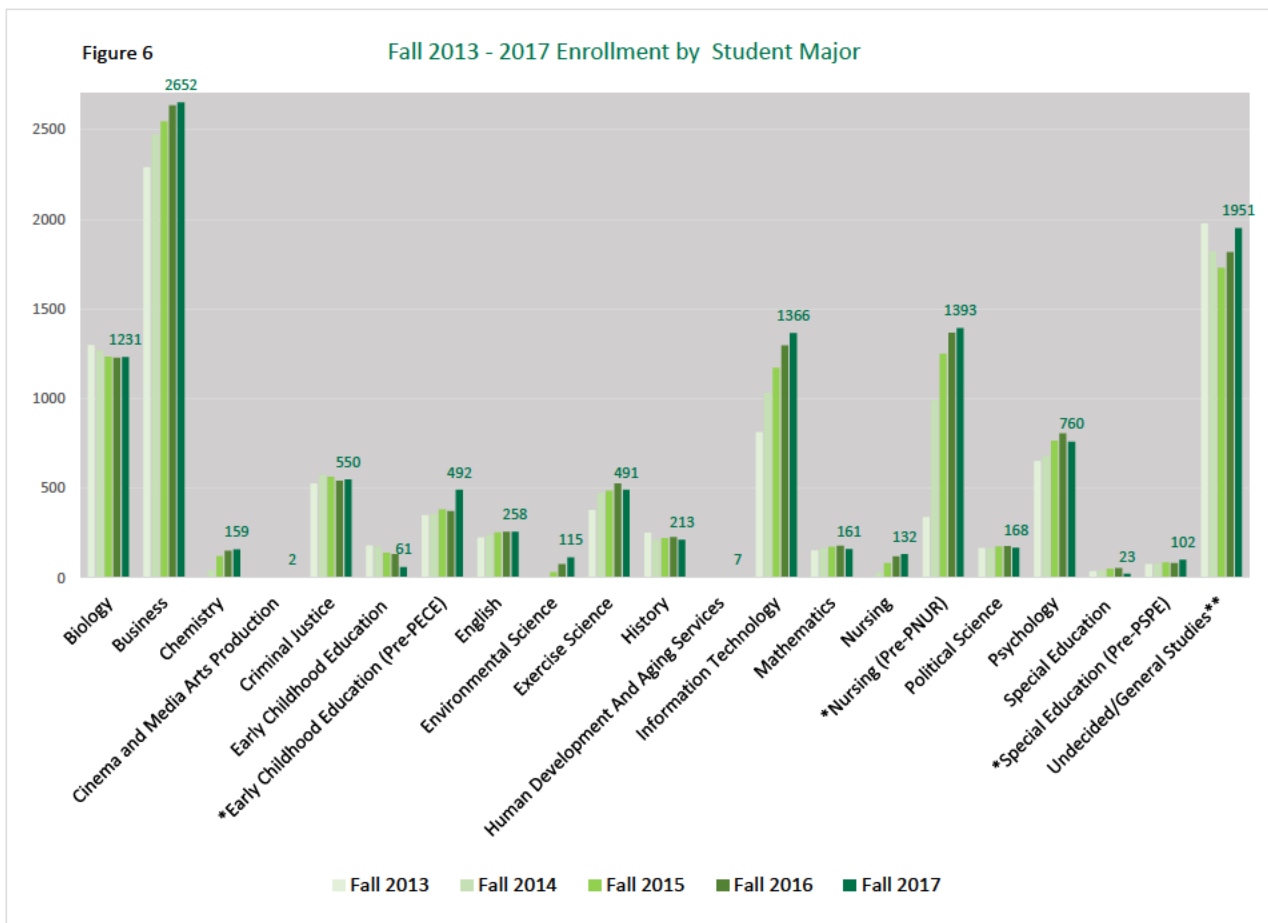

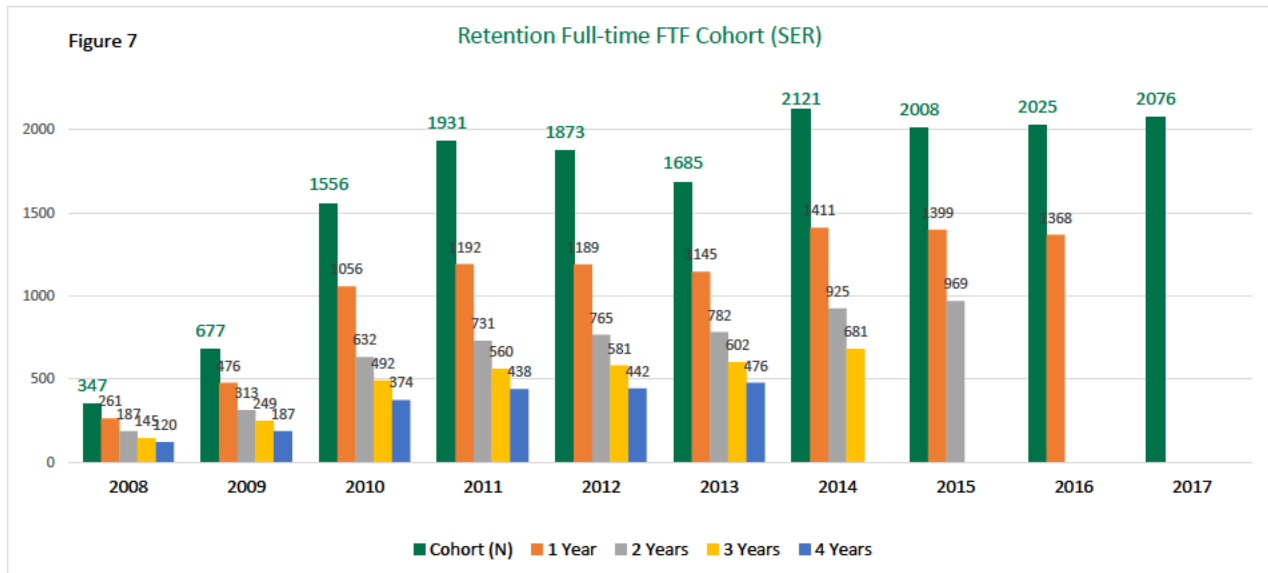

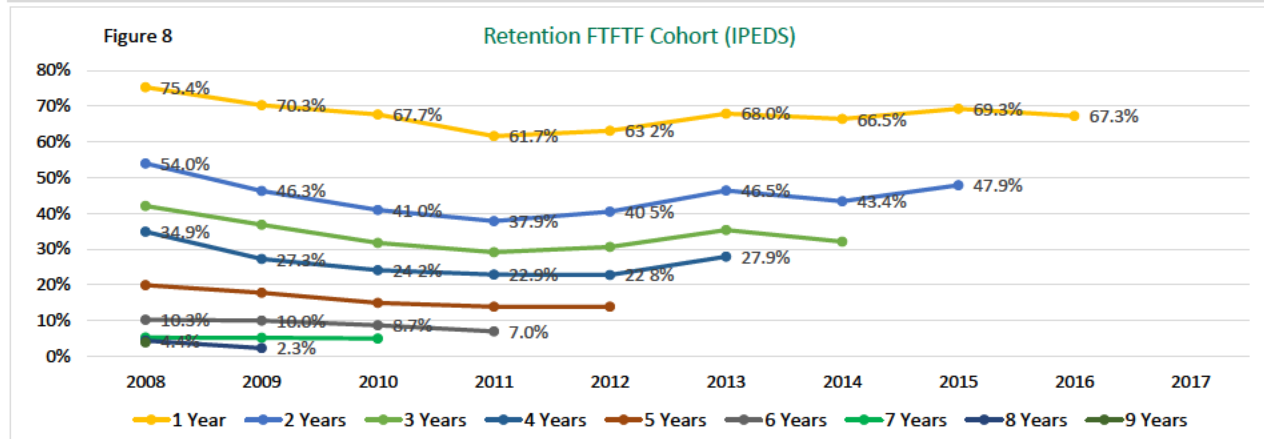

Retention and Graduation Rates of Full-time First-time Freshmen

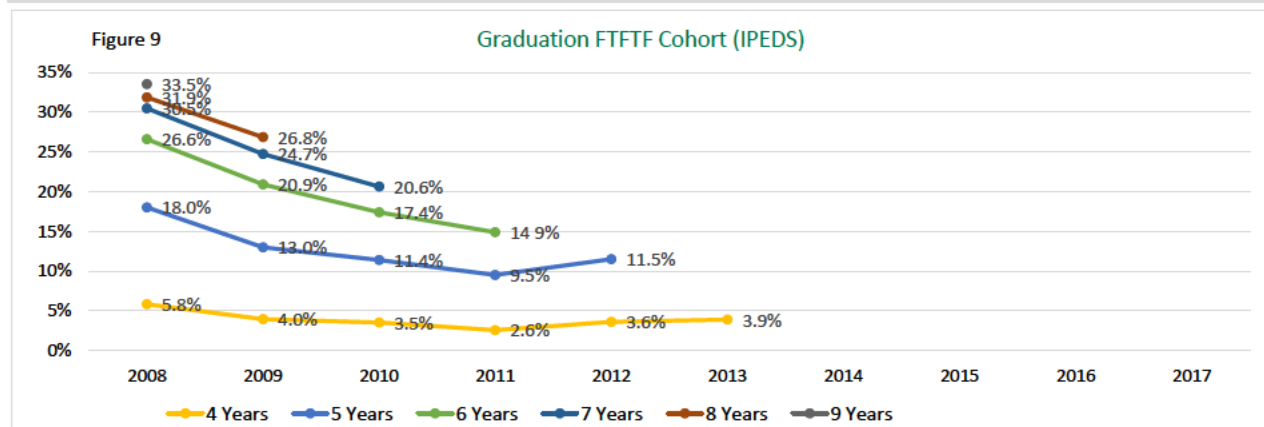

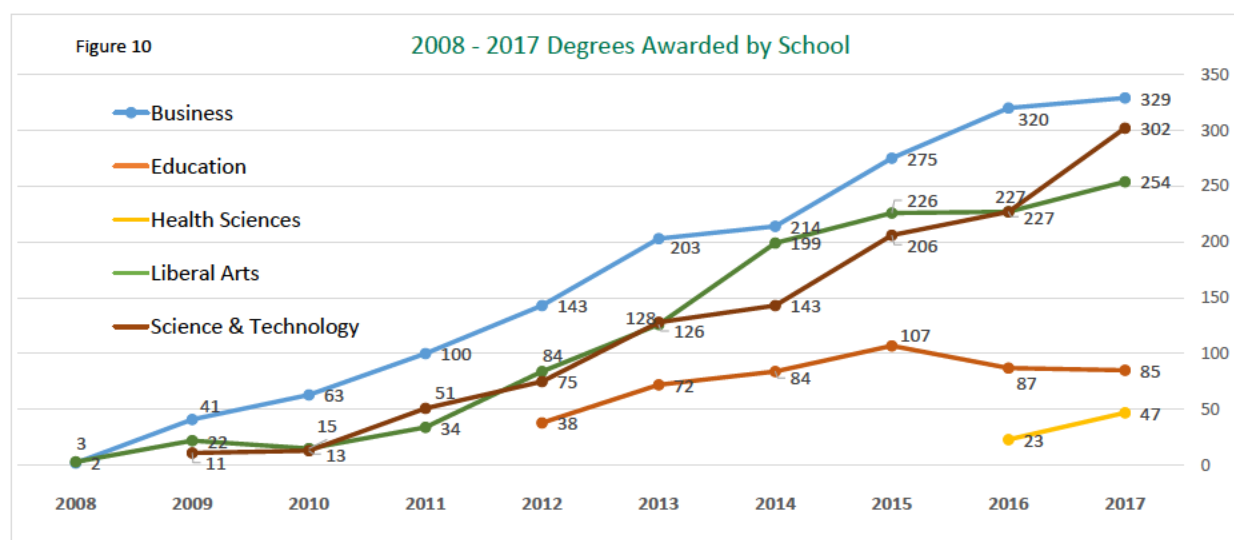
