What to Donate

- Breakfast (boxed or cup options)
- Ready in seconds meals and soups (canned or microwaveable cup/bowl options)
- **Snacks** (chicken salad or tuna salad shelf-stable kits)
- **Dry goods:** macaroni and cheese (cups/boxes), mashed potatoes, plain crackers, any boxed ready to make meals, spaghetti (or any pastas)

- Kitchenware items: can opener
